- <sup>11</sup> Soon afterward Jesus went with his disciples to the village of Nain, and a large crowd followed him. <sup>12</sup> A funeral procession was **coming out** as he approached the village gate. ## LUKE 7:13-15 (NLT)

- <sup>13</sup> When the Lord saw her, his heart overflowed with **compassion**. “Don’t cry!” he said. <sup>14</sup> Then he walked over to the coffin and touched it, and the bearers stopped. “Young man,” he said, “I tell you, get up.” <sup>15</sup> Then the dead boy sat up and began to talk! And Jesus gave him back to his mother.

## 1 JOHN 3:18-19 (NLT)

- <sup>18</sup> Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions. <sup>19</sup> Our actions will show that we belong to the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before God.

# compassion

[*kuh m-pash-uh* n]

**noun**

1. a feeling of deep sympathy and sorrow for another who is stricken by misfortune, accompanied by a strong desire to alleviate their suffering.

## PSALM 78:38 (KJV)

- <sup>38</sup> But he, *being* full of compassion, forgave *their* iniquity, and destroyed *them* not: Yea, many a time turned he his anger away, And did not stir up all his wrath.



# COMPASSION SHOULD **MOVE** YOU

- **Matthew 9:36 (KJV 1900)**
- <sup>36</sup> But when he saw the multitudes, **he was moved with compassion** on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
  
- **Matthew 14:14 (KJV 1900)**
- <sup>14</sup> And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was **moved with compassion** toward them, and he healed their sick.
