June 21st Weapons Mighty in God

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 NIV

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

June 22nd Power through the Holy Spirit

2 Corinthians 6: 3-10 NIV

We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed. But in all things we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; by purity, by knowledge, by long suffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and yet true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.

June 23rd Protected by God

Isaiah 54:17 NIV

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me Says the Lord.

June 24th Put on the Whole Armor

Ephesians 6:11-13 NIV

Put on the whole armor of god, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the whole armor of god, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

June 25th Stand

Ephesians 6:14-17 NIV

Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the spirit, which is the word of God.

June 26th Bind, Loose, Ask and Think

Matthew 16:19 NIV

I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. ask or think, according to the power that works in us.

June 27th Declare Great and Mighty

Jeremiah 33:3 NIV

Call to me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know in us.

June 28th God Given Authority

Luke 10:19 NIV

Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

3. FAST – Ask God to reveal what carnal thing, practice, or person God wants you to let go.

Jesus implied that all of His followers should fast. (Matthew 6:16-18; 9:14,15.) Spiritual fasting makes us less self-centered and frees us from the confines of what we want or *think* we need. Through fasting and prayer, we humble ourselves before God so the Holy Spirit will stir our souls, awaken our churches, and heal our land. (2 Chronicles 7:14.) While you need not fast from food, pray about the kind of fast you should undertake.
