Solid Waste Driver/ Facility Maintenance Worker- Primary duty is general maintenance of Solid Waste Division facilities and fleet vehicles. The incumbent will also be responsible for completing special pickups, and operating a boom truck, and will also be called upon to serve as driver of refuse and recycling trucks as needed when primary drivers are not available.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Two (2) years of experience in routine facility maintenance work or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Possession of valid Class B restricted license with air brake endorsement
- Good driving record
- Ability to work in a team environment.
- Willingness to work outdoors in all-weather.
- Ability to compile a sound work attendance record.
- Must be able to work in a physically strenuous environment, which includes repetitive lifting and walking for long periods.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds
